#### MOVING TO GOD'S JUDGMENT

Isaiah 1-12 Ezekiel 1-10 Jeremiah 1-10

- Some in our past history
- Some in our still-future years [Great Tribulation]

The judgment of God is not a popular topic.

Jeremiah was jailed for his prophecy of judgment.

No one listened/heeded Isaiah's prophecy of judgment.

Ezekiel's prophecy was ridiculed.

#### Background: Israel and YHWH

- Abraham and the Promise
- Moses Exodus Law Tabernacle
- Saul ["we want a king like the other nations"]
- David Plans 1st Temple
- Solomon Builds 1st Temple
- Civil War Israel-N Judah-S *Many godless kings*
- Hilkiah finds the Law and gives it to Josiah [his grandson is Jehoiachin]
- Isaiah prophesies of judgment
- Jeremiah prophesies of judgment [left in Jerusalem, then Egypt]
- Daniel prophesies of 70 Shabua for Israel and Jerusalem
- Ezekiel prophesies of judgment [from Babylon]

#### WHY Judgment?

- Israel the adulteress wife of Jehovah Hosea 1:1-2 take harlot Gomer as wife Pagan/Heathen idols alongside YHWH Judges 2:17 play harlot with other gods 1st Kings 3:2 14:23 Lev. 26:30 Numbers 22:41 Asherim 'high places'
- Ignored the land's *Shabbat* for 490 years 2<sup>nd</sup> Chron. 36:21 Lev. 25 [David to Jehoiachin]
- Ezekiel prophesies 390 + 40 = 430 yrs total [leaves 360 yrs after Babylon 70]
- Jeremiah prophesies 70 years captivity/exile 32:6-15 buys cousin Hanamel's land in Anathoth after 70 years "houses-fields-vineyards deals will happen again"
- God silent from Malachi to the Baptist [397 BC to 29 AD]
- Mashiach fulfills Passover Daniel 9:24-26 62 + 7 sevens
- Ezekiel 37 restore Israel to the land "dry bones" [May 1948] 16:8-21 YHWH will restore Israel as His wife Deut. 10:12-15





Ezekiel 3 God sends him to Israel, but they will NOT listen to him God takes him to Chebar in Tel-Abib exile as "Watchman" v22 God's Spirit fills him . . . hands bound + speak only when God allows

#### 4 SIGNS

Ezekiel 4:1-8 Build a model of siege that's coming
Once per day on L 390 days for Israel + on R 40 days for Judah
Hair into thirds represent death by: 1] plague, 2] famine, 3] sword
v15 reproach, reviling, warning to nations surrounding Israel
Ezekiel 6+7 Prophesy judgment on God's people

                   Appears to be a vision, could be actual physical move
                       Acts 8:40 Philip to Ashdod 2nd Corinth. 12 Saul to 3rd Heaven

              Idol-image-statue in N gate of Temple to Babylon goddess Astarte
                     2<sup>nd</sup> Kings 21, 2<sup>nd</sup> Chron. 33 Manasseh's idol-blasphemy
              Pagan worship happening in the Temple in secret chambers
  v 6-12
                     YHWH will leave the Temple due to Israel's sin
                     v 7-8 Ezekiel digs into wall - views sin within priests' chambers
                     v 9-10 idols/statues of creeping things, beasts on the walls
                            Romans 1:25-26 worship creature rather than Creator
   v 11 Jazaniah son of Shaphan [implemented Josiah's revival back to YHWH]
              but Jazaniah takes people back to pagan-heathen worship
             Jeremiah 26:24 29:3 36:10-12 39:14

have you seen what they do in the dark? In chambers of idols? Ephesians 5:11 do not participate in the <u>unfruitful</u> deeds of darkness

[God doesn't see all the time?]

v 13-14

Jewish women crying over Tammuz [Phoenician] son of Babel Queen Semiramis + Nimrod [Greeks 'Adonis' husband of Ishtar] Dies at winter solstice then raised to life Fires lit to guide-usher him back from the underworld during 'darkest day of the year' Evergreen tree decorated with gold Tammuz tree burned then back to life Babylon term for youth "Yule" [Canaan 'Ba-al' Egypt 'Osiris' Sumer "Dumuzi']

Ezekiel 9:3 God's visible 'Presence' departs the Temple, exits Jerusalem

9:4 God will mark His Faithful Remnant in the city



They will not perish in the siege and destruction WOW! "mark upon the forehead" to set them apart

Ancient paleo-Hebrew: In tav final letter in alphabet

How cool is this! God sealing His people with a cross on forehead

Remember: 1st Peter 4:17 time for judgment to start with the household of God if it begins with them, what about those with no regard for God?

Jeremiah 7:4 don't trust deceptive words saying, "this is the Temple"

[as if God could not execute on/within His own Temple]

v 9-10 iniquity of Judah and Israel is VERY great, land full of perversion but God will have no pity and will no spare judgment on them

Compare with Romans 9 Saul notes what NO other nation has except Israel [unique] adoption as sons glory of Covenants Law Temple service promises

#### **Ezekiel**

- **Prophesying Judgment** is quite the responsibility.

  Calling out the priests' private sin and idolatry **not easy to do!**
- ALL in Jerusalem watched the glory of the Lord's presence depart

  THAT must have been quite the discussions-debates-comments . . .
- God's Glory is gone from Jerusalem Temple for 500+ years NEXT time it is seen?
- 1] Matt.-17 Mark-9 Luke-9 Jesus transfigured alongside Moses and Elijah John, James, Peter eyewitnesses
- 2] Ezekiel 43:2-7 44:4 God's glory <u>does return</u> to Millennium Temple to cleanse the people


