While Isaiah Jeremiah and Ezekiel are clearly the "Big-3" of OT prophets, their Words from God perfectly complement the "other prophets" such as:

Amos, Joel, Psalms, Micah, Malachi, Zephaniah, Zechariah, Hosea, Joshua, Ruth, Samuel, Job, Abraham, Daniel, Moses, Jonah . . .

Isaiah Jeremiah Ezekiel KNEW their prophecies were not for them in their time

Hebrews 1:1 God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many times and various ways, has now spoked thru His Son Jesus

Saul/Paul the Apostle quotes the Prophets 40 TIMES throughout Hebrews building a strong apologia for Jesus being Mashiach, including:

Psalm 45:6 Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, a scepter of uprightness is the scepter of Your kingdom

The prophets who prophesied were singularly focused on "1 Topic" as they were ALL inspired by the same Holy Spirit with a *single integrated narrative!*

Prophets Who Prophesied

- 1. INCREDIBLE precision in people, places, dates
- 2. FULLY-COORDINATED throughout Earth's history
- 3. COMPLEMENTARY to all other prophecies
- 4. CONFIRMING time and again in Exact fulfillment
